It is important too to be reminded of the precise goals of the community, its call and its origins. In too many communities, the essentials are obscured in a thousand and one activities. Their members no longer know why they are together or to what they should be witnessing. They discuss the details but forget what brought them together.

Leaders of communities must continually announce the vision and remind members of the call of God; priests and spiritual guides must announce the vision and remind members of the call of God. Each member is called to announce the vision and remind the others of the call of God.

Day in and day out, we must remind each other with words of enthusiasm and of love. We forget so quickly and fall into the ways of the world, seeking security, shunning the Beatitudes, refusing to forgive enemies. Jean Vanier *Community and Growth*, rev. ed., p. 176-7.
